We need your help

In an effort to get fiber throughout the city in an economical way we are currently looking into various grant opportunities. In order to qualify for these grants we need to show/prove we have an “unserved” (less than 25mbps) and or “underserved” (less than 100mbps) population. Please go to the governor’s office of economic development state broadband speed test site:

<https://business.utah.gov/broadband/speed-test/#test> .

At this site it will ask you to choose between the following:

- Use my GPS Location
- Enter my exact address
- Enter my partial address (if you are concerned about privacy, choose this)
- Enter an address with NO AVAILABLE SERVICE

1. Fill in in your address and the amount you are currently paying for your internet service (this will help determine whether the internet service in the area is “affordable”). The governing body have not determined what that amount is presently.
2. Select “Check Address” – this will take you to the next page
3. Check the box to indicate that you agree to the data policy
4. Select “Begin”

A speed test will be performed the speed test which will be recorded and associated with your address creating a map which will help the Governor’s office during the grant selection cycle.

By working together we can identify problems and find resolutions that will continue to keep Alpine a safe and amazing place to live and raise our families.



Do you have a water leak?



With the installation of the new meters, you may now get an app on your phone or use your computer to monitor your daily water use. It will also alert you if you have a leak, which will save you \$ and precious water.

To sign up on your computer, go to EyeOneWater.com and create an account using your zip code and your Alpine City account #, which is on your water bill. Use all the numbers but don't type the decimal point. (account 382.7 would be 3827)

To get the app on your phone, go to your App Store and search for Eye On Water. Choose the one that says "Making Water Visible" with the blue water droplet. Get the app, Install app, Open, Sign Up, Enter zip code and account # (no decimal point), Continue, Yes, that's me, Create account, enter email, create password, accept account terms, Verify email. Go to your email, find the one from Eye On Water, click Verify My Email, Enable notifications.
