NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Alpine City will hold a General Municipal Election on
November 7, 2023 for the following offices:

Three (3) City Council seats	4-year term
Candidate Filing period begins:	Thursday, June 1, 2023 at 8 am.
Candidate Filing period ends:	Wednesday, June 7, 2023 at 5 pm.

Qualifications for Candidacy are:

- Be a United States Citizen
- Be a registered voter of the municipality
- Be a resident of the municipality or recently annexed area for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
- Be mentally competent
- Not be convicted of a felony or treason unless the right to hold elective office has been restored.

Declaration of Candidacy forms or Nomination Petitions must be filed in person with the City Recorder at Alpine City Hall, 20 North Main, Alpine, Utah. The week of June 1st -7th, 2023 between the business hours of 8 am and 5 pm. An individual may also file remotely or through a designated agent if the individual is located outside the state during the entire filing period. E-Bikes

In an effort to promote safety for all our residents please be aware of the following regarding E-bikes:

- Class 1 E-bikes: motor only engaged if you are pedaling. It does NOT have a throttle
- Class 2 E-bikes: has a throttle and speed maxes out at 20mph
- Class 3 E-bikes: has a throttle and speed can go over 20mph

State code: 41-6a-1115.5

- (4) An individual under 16 years old may not operate a class 3 electric assisted bicycle.
- (5) An individual under 14 years old may not operate an electric assisted bicycle with the electric motor engaged on any public property, highway, path, or sidewalk unless the individual is under the direct supervision of the individual's parent or guardian.



Odd numbered addresses—Mon, Wed, Fri * Even numbered addresses—Tue, Thu, Sat*

Hours to water are between 7 pm to 7 am. Odd addresses may begin watering at 7 pm on Monday. Even addresses may begin watering at 7 pm on Tuesday. And so on.

City parks, schools, churches, and agricultural users will be on a different schedule. In order to balance the use, they may be watering during the day.

* You are not obligated to water 3 times a week. Some have found better results watering 2 times a week for

EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

The Emergency Management community in Utah County has come together to provide ALL citizens within the county, a system in which they can sign up to be alerted in the event of an emergency. Such alerts may be helpful for you to know when its necessary to take immediate action. CODE COMPLIANCE CORNER

Many of our residents have noticed the small, temporary signs that are posted along City roads and find them annoying. These signs are actually illegal. The placement of any of these types of signs along City right-of-ways (including park strips) is in violation of Section 3.25 of the City Code. In addition, any sign advertising a commercial business or service in a residential area is also prohibited (3.25.060 – Off premise commercial signs are prohibited).

The next time your window washer, landscaper, house cleaner, etc. asks if they can put their sign up in your front yard, please let them know that they are not allowed. If found, these signs will be removed by the Alpine City Code Compliance Officer. Businesses who are deemed repeat offenders of this practice may be fined and found guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.

Please help keep our residential neighborhoods clutter free of this commercial advertising.
