

Alpine City Social Media Use Agreement

This user agreement (“Agreement”) governs the use of Alpine City’s social media sites maintained by City staff. Please read this Agreement carefully. Your use of Alpine City’s social networking pages constitutes your agreement to comply with this Agreement. If you do not agree, please do not use Alpine City’s networking pages.

This Agreement may be modified at any time. Continued access to Alpine City’s social media pages constitutes your acceptance of any changes or revisions. Failure to follow the terms of this Agreement may result in suspension or termination of your access without notice.

Alpine City does not endorse, support, sanction, encourage, verify, or agree with comments, opinions, or statements posted by outside individuals or parties. Any information or material placed online, including advice and opinions, are the views and responsibilities of those making the comments and do not necessarily represent the views of Alpine City. By submitting a comment, you agree that Alpine City and its third-party service providers are not responsible and shall have no liability with respect to information posted by others, including defamatory, offensive, or illicit material, even if it violates this Agreement.

All comments and posts may be considered public records and subject to retention and disclosure under applicable public disclosure laws. Alpine City social media sites serve as a limited public forum, and all content is subject to monitoring. Alpine City reserves the right, but undertakes no duty, to review, edit, move, reject, or remove content at its sole discretion and without notice if it violates this Agreement.

Prohibited Content

To maintain a constructive and lawful environment, the following content is not allowed on Alpine City social media sites:

- Abusive, obscene, vulgar, sexually explicit language, materials, or symbols (including grawlix-style profanity)
- Threatening, harassing, defamatory, or discriminatory language
- Content that discriminates based on federally protected classes (race, sex, sexual orientation, gender, religion, national origin, age, or disability)
- Offensive terms targeting individuals or groups
- Content that incites, promotes, or glorifies violence, illegal activity, or dangerous behavior
- Information that could reasonably compromise individual or public safety
- Personal identifying or sensitive information (e.g., phone numbers, emails, postal addresses)
- Spam, repetitive or irrelevant posts, and off-topic comments
- Commercial advertising, promotional content, or solicitation of services
- Promotion of non-profit services or products
- Advertising of events sponsored by groups other than a public organization
- Links to external websites for promotional or malicious purposes
- Political campaigning, lobbying, or promotion/endorsement of candidates or ballot issues
